# **Request for Information Under the Community Right-to-Know Laws**

The Emergency Planning & Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA), also known as Title III of the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act (SARA), was signed into law on October 17, 1986 by Congress as national legislation on community safety. This law is designed to help local communities protect public health, safety, and the environment from chemical hazards.

The public has a right to know the chemical/hazardous materials information disclosed to the New Mexico Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management under the provisions of Title III of the Superfund Amendment and Reauthorization Act (SARA) of 1986 and the New Mexico Hazardous Chemicals Information Act, NMSA 1978 Sections 74-4E-1 through -9 (2021).

Please note the following conditions when requesting information:

- 1. A separate request form is required for each facility.
- 2. Photo Identification is required before any information will be released.
- 3. Information indicating locations of hazardous materials storage/handling will not be released.
- 4. Information that is protected under the Privacy Act will not be released.
- 5. Information that has been designated by the facility as a trade secret, requires additional time and procedures. The Hazardous Materials Program will advise you of these additional procedures.
- 6. If the information requested is not available, you will be notified in writing.
