 - Changes will be made

- The secretary stated he would put the HMER plan under a departmental hat and that it should be published NLT 31 December 2018
- Henry Jolly also stated that the next plan for review would be the New Mexico State Mitigation Plan for Technological and Human Caused Hazards
 - This plan requires a four year review
 - We will be hosting a working group meeting with the subject matter experts of this plan
- A lot of time was spent this last summer repairing damage to the Tier II database
 - Third party software from other companies which did not follow indexing rules, caused several file bugs in our database
 - Henry Jolly stated that he was working closely with NOAA to resolve the issue
 - The reports are now on e-team by county name for download. The plan is to notify all the Hazmat Fire Department and LEPCs in order to get them access to e-team so they can download their files for the CAMEO Suite
 - Henry Jolly stated that he was working with the Emergency Operations
 Center personnel in order to get the files online for download
 Henry Jolly stated that NOAA was in development of a new TIER II
 Submit Database for release in approximately two years
 - Henry Jolly Stated that we had 25,171 facilities reported this year for Tier II Reports
- The secretary briefed on the changes to the 2018 Grant
 - Funding is aimed at Typed teams
 - Teams have to opt into E-Map
- Henry Jolly Stated that the new three year grant would be going out in January for requests
 - Henry Jolly detailed thing that are allowed to be funded by HMEP
- Henry Jolly said Steve Mason would be retiring. The secretary suggested doing six seminars throughout the state for the LEPC 101 that Steve had been doing.
- The Secretary suggested holding a training event for Industry and their use of the Tier to Submit program
- Henry Jolly stated that we have 6 of the seven SERC positions filled
- Henry Jolly stated the letter of appointment for the SERC are out dated
 - The secretary stated he would look into the letters
- Henry Jolly stated that a new position had been opened for a new boss to help with HMEP and Tier II
- Henry Jolly stated that there are 31 of 33 LEPCs up and running
- Janine Kraemer brought up the recent Mercury incident. Henry Jolly stated that the next Hazmat Safety board would discuss this incident in detail
- Mark Rowley asked about the Orphan Fund. He stated that the fund was not being funded and maybe we should look for a way to fund it and name responsibility for the fund

- The Secretary suggested the SERC review the Public Law in an upcoming meeting and to compile a list of changes and to find a sponsor
- The Secretary suggested February of 2019 for the next big meeting
- The Secretary suggested a SERC telecom on the 29th of November to do old business only
